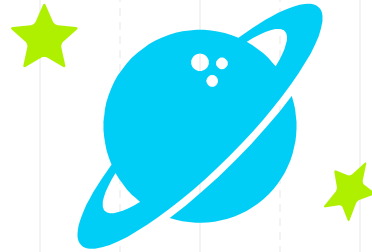

Recovery Teams

Immediately following every worship experience a team will sanitize all doors, handles, chairs, etc. This team will be equipped with personal protective gear as well.

Bathrooms

Bathrooms will be frequently cleared of partners and sanitized. A host will also be stationed there to ensure they are not overcrowded and distancing maintained. Additionally, the back hallway will be marked and directed to one way traffic.

Hand Sanitation Stations

New hand sanitizer dispensers have been installed nearly every 20 feet of occupied spaces in the building. Feel free to use as often as necessary.

We will NOT be hosting the following amenities

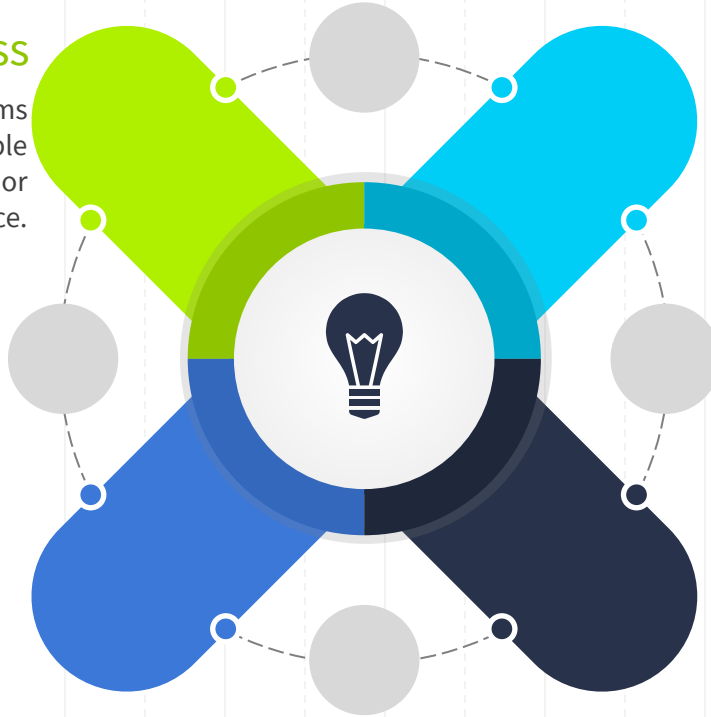


2nd Floor Access

The fellowship hall and upstairs bathrooms are closed to minimize possible contaminated spaces. No classes or meetings will be held in this space.

On Site ANWA Store

Our All Nations store will be taking online orders only. Orders will be available for pick up on site each week. This will minimize partners cross contaminating open sitting merchandise.



Nursery

Our beautiful space for our sweet babies 6 weeks - 24 months will be closed until further notice. This will ensure they stay close to their parents and are not placed at risk in any way.

WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN YOU ARRIVE ... PLEASE PLAN TO BE EARLY



DOORS WILL OPEN 30 MINUTES PRIOR

Please arrive early to allow for ease with possible further parking, waiting in line to check-in and be temperature screened. You will be allowed to enter earlier to minimize contact with others.



TEMPERATURE SCREENING

All attendees will be temperature screened with a contact-free device. Individuals with an elevated temperature (>100) will be referred to the health care team and asked to worship virtually instead.



PRE- REGISTRATION VERIFICATION

Registration is required ahead of time. You will be asked for a name on the reservation and the entire party will need to present and enter together.



WEAR A MASK

It is still highly suggested that masks be worn in gatherings. If you do not have one or forget don't worry, one will be made available for you.



REMAIN WITH YOUR IMMEDIATE FAMILY

You will be asked to sit with your immediate family only. Please leave 3 seats between you and the next party. TLO will assist in organization.



MAINTAIN PHYSICAL DISTANCING

Please practice 6ft distancing protocol. Waving, gestures and verbal acknowledgement are preferred to hugs, high fives, or shaking hands.



Frequently Asked Questions



● Why do I have to wear a face mask?

We know face masks are uncomfortable. An important part of our corporate gatherings is singing together. While primary transmission of COVID-19 seems to occur through respiratory droplets and physical contact, there is also concern about aerosol transmission. No face mask can eliminate all particles of course, but knowing that masks may reduce the transmission of potentially infected particles and that a number of people may be asymptomatic carriers of the coronavirus, for your health and the safety of others around you, please strongly consider wearing a face mask to worship. Remember, if you don't have a face mask, we can give you one at the door.

● "Why are you making people register for worship?"

The primary reason we are asking everyone to use the online RSVP program is so we can ensure that we are in compliance with our Governor's request that worship venues not exceed a certain capacity. The online RSVP system is to help us get as many people as we responsibly and safely without having to turn people away at the door once those rooms are full. We don't want people to leave the safety of their homes thinking they are going to be able to participate in an in-person worship experience only to be turned away. Furthermore, it allows for us to know who is on campus at ALL times. If you're uneasy with RSVPing over the internet, no problem please call the church office and we can assist you.

① "Will you continue broadcasting the worship services online?"

Yes! We will live-stream the 11:00 am worship experience on our Facebook page and YouTube.

② What about our other gatherings - prayer, classes, small groups, activations etc.?

All other gatherings will remain online. Our goal is to solidify systems on Sundays and then slowly add other in person experiences. Prayer will continue to stream live on Wednesdays. Pastoral services are still available by appointment only.
